

## PHY 102 Laboratory Regulations

Dear students,

The following regulations are to be applied in PHY 102 lab sessions. Please read all items carefully and attend your lab sessions in accordance with them.

- 1) Announcements concerning lab sessions will be sent through [sis.thk.edu.tr](http://sis.thk.edu.tr) by your course instructors and will be available on [odk.thk.edu.tr](http://odk.thk.edu.tr) .
- 2) Most important issue concerning lab sessions is safety. Follow all instructions coming from the lab instructors properly. Do not turn your set up on until you are sure that all connections are proper and your power supply is at 0 Volts.
- 3) Lab session starts on time and ends on time. Duration of each lab session is 2 hours. At the end of the lab session all students have to submit their reports even in the case when their reports are not completed.
- 4) Lab manual (which will be available on and is to be downloaded from [odk.thk.edu.tr](http://odk.thk.edu.tr)), graph papers, ruler and calculator are to be brought by the students. There is no resource to supply these items to the students by the school.
- 5) Lab instructors are in charge during lab sessions. Students are expected to follow all instructions declared by the lab instructors.
- 6) For this semester, 3 experiments have been planned. Each student regularly attends lab sessions twice a week. If you miss any lab session without an officially acceptable excuse, this will cause you fail from the course. So, do not miss your lab sessions.
- 7) Some topics which are of importance in experiments and data analysis (like the rules of recording measured values, significant figures etc.) have been given during the first semester and a document including information on such topics will be available on [odk.thk.edu.tr](http://odk.thk.edu.tr) . The basic knowledge of these topics are in the responsibility of the students. So, study your experiment and experimentation basics before coming to lab.
- 8) All equipments present in the laboratories belong to the university. Any damage given to laboratory equipment is under responsibility of the person causing that damage. You are expected to be aware of the possible consequences of your actions during the lab sessions.
- 9) In case of any problems concerning lab sessions, consult to Dr. M. Ali Olpak ([maolpak@thk.edu.tr](mailto:maolpak@thk.edu.tr)). If you have or you expect to have attendance issues, report your situation before missing the relevant lab session so that the problem can be solved.
